3 APPLICATION FOR A PERSONAL LICENCE

In addition the Sub-Committee took account of its obligations under s17 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 and Article 1 of the First Protocol of the Human Rights Act 1998.

The Sub-Committee received the report of the Licensing Officer. Representation had against the application from the Metropolitan Police as a Responsible Authority on the Grounds of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder and a response from the applicant.

Upon careful consideration the Sub-Committee decided not to grant the Personal Licence.
