Part A – Report seeking decision

DETAIL OF THE DECISION REQUESTED AND RECOMMENDED ACTION

This Executive Decision approves the proposed road closures in Sunnings Lane, Upminster following the completion of a statutory consultation and based on the recommendations of the Council's Highways Advisory Committee held on 5th September 2017.

Details of the measures are contained in the report and are shown on drawing Nos. QQ033-OF-103 and QQ033-OF-104.

Council's Constitution

STATEMENT OF THE REASONS FOR THE DECISION

At its meeting held on 5th September 2017 the Highways Advisory Committee (HAC) considered a report (Agenda Item 8) on the proposals (copy attached) and the following recommendations:

That the Committee having considered the report and the representations made recommends to the Cabinet Member for Environment and Community Safety that the following measures are implemented:

The HAC having considered the report (Agenda Item 8) on 5th September 2017, made the following recommendations;

1. Closure of Sunnings Lane, junction with Dennises Lane to vehicular traffic with the exception of access to cyclists, pedestrians and horse riders as shown on drawing No. QQ033-OF-103.

2. Closure of Sunnings Lane by Sullens Farm entrance at a location below:

At a point 25 metres (approximately) south of the entrance of Sullens Farm as shown on drawing No. QQ033-OF-104.

3. Members note that the estimated cost for implementation of the road closures is £0.02m. The funding for carrying out the works is not yet available but is subject to a separate bid which will be made for corporate capital funds. Stakeholders were made aware throughout consultation that the works would only be carried out if capital funding becomes available but by going through the consultation process in advance, the scheme is ready to be installed as soon as funding is agreed.

The HAC having considered the report (Agenda Item 8) on 5th September 2017, and made the following recommendations;

1. That the scheme be implemented as advertised.

The decision reflects the recommendations of the HAC and adopts the justification for the decision set out in the report to the HAC.


