Part A - Report seeking decision

DETAIL OF THE DECISION REQUESTED AND RECOMMENDED ACTION

That having considered the information contained in this report, the Assistant Director for Environment authorises the implementation of 'Keep Clear' road markings on road safety grounds.at various locations in the borough.

Details of the proposals are contained in the report and are shown on attached drawings in Appendix 2.

AUTHORITY UNDER WHICH DECISION IS MADE

Council's Constitution

Part 3, Section 3.8.3, Assistant Director, Environment, Paragraph (dd)

To determine the provision, positioning and layout of road signs and other street furniture.

STATEMENT OF THE REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Council proposes to implement 'Keep Clear' road markings, on road safety grounds, at the following locations in the borough:

- A118 Main Road, Romford outside Creative Kids Nursery, drawing No. QQ31/92/01.
- ii) Butts Green Rd, Hornchurch-outside Creative Kids Nursery, drawing No. QQ31/92/02.
- iii) Upper Rainham Road junction with Bancroft Chase, drawing No. QQ31/117
- iv) Cherry Tree Lane junction with Dunedin Road, drawing No. QQ31115
- v) Marsh Way junction with southern roundabout with the A13, Rainham, drawing

Reasons: During peak times, traffic exiting from side roads into main roads, is being regularly obscured by long queues of traffic tailing back from main road junctions during peak periods. While some drivers on the main roads are courteous in allowing drivers to enter into or exit from the side roads many are not which can adversely affect the traffic flow and increase traffic flow.

The introduction of Keep Clear road markings at Marsh Way junction (item v above) follows a request by the management of London Riverside Business Improvement District (BID). They explained that due unexpected traffic congestion occurring on the A13, the existing roundabouts are blocked whereby gaining exit to alternative routes leads to considerable delays particularly in

Proposed road markings: To overcome the problem, it is proposed to provide keep clear markings at a number of sites. These markings are designed to act as a deterrent to vehicles blocking junctions and roundabouts by creating a gap in the traffic queue.

Keep Clear road markings are advisory only and are not supported by Traffic Management Orders. Although the markings are not enforceable they have proved effective at other sites throughout the borough.

Financial Allocation

The sum of £5,000 for the implementation for the road markings would be met from the 2017/18 allocation for Borough Roads, Minor Safety Improvements (A24010).

OTHER OPTIONS CONSIDERED AND REJECTED

An alternative option was considered and this is detailed as below:

Do Nothing option was considered, but it is not considered appropriate on road safety grounds particularly for drivers exiting from side roads with restricted visibility by stationery traffic on both sides in the main roads.

PRE-DECISION CONSULTATION

The management of London Riverside Business Improvement District (BID) were consulted and they have endorsed the proposals.

Part B - Assessment of implications and risks

LEGAL IMPLICATIONS AND RISKS

The Council has powers to install traffic signs on its road network by virtue of powers granted under Part V of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, with S65 granting powers and giving duties for the placing of traffic signs.

The form and conditions under which traffic signs may be installed are prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 and "keep clear" markings are prescribed traffic signs for this purpose.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS AND RISKS

The estimated cost of £ 5,000 will be met from 2017/18 revenue allocation for Borough Roads, Minor Safety Improvements (A24010). Attached in Appendix 1 is a detailed breakdown of the costs.


