## MINUTES OF A MEETING OF A LICENSING SUB-COMMITTEE 23 August 2005 (10.40am – 10.55am)

Mr S Vaughan the Designated Premises Supervisor was present on behalf of the applicant, Greene King Brewing & Retailing Ltd,

Paul Campbell (Havering Licensing) Derron Jarell (Legal advisor to the Sub-Committee) and Grant Söderberg (Clerk) were also present.

The Chairman advised those present of action to be taken in the event of emergency evacuation of the Town Hall becoming necessary.

## THE ARCHERS PUBLIC HOUSE – APPLICATION TO VARY A PREMISES LICENCE

The Sub-Committee received a report outlining the application that was presented by the Licensing Officer.

The premises were currently permitted to open Monday to Sunday 10.00 hours to 23.00 hours, Christmas Day 12.00 hours to 15.00 hours and 19.00 hours to 22.30 hours and New Years Eve 10.00 hours to 23.00 hours New Years Day.

The Sub-Committee noted that there were no representations by members of the public who lived in the vicinity of the premises or on a transitory route from the venue.

The Sub-Committee had also been provided with a copy letter and an email from the applicant to the police and licensing office, stating that the applicant accepted the comments from the police and had addressed their objections by amending the application to:

"remove extensions for non standard dates", but they requested that bank holiday extensions should remain.

As such, the police were satisfied that the applicant had addressed their concerns and that as agreement now existed, were no longer objecting to the amended application.

As the police had been the only objector to the application and this had been addressed, the Sub-Committee RESOLVED, that the application submitted by Greene King Brewing & Retailing Ltd. for a transfer of the existing licence be granted. The Sub-Committee also RESOLVED to grant permission for the variation to hours as agreed between the applicant and the police as follows:

Supply of alcohol:

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Furthermore the Sub-Committee set the following conditions:

- The function room is to close at 00.00 hours.
- The whole premises is to close by 00.30 hours.
- Seasonal variations were granted.
- The additional hour "proceeding and preceding day before a bank holiday" is granted under Greene King's explanation that it means the day before the bank holiday and the bank holiday itself.
