REPORT OF THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE

SUBJECT: CREATION OF ADDITIONAL MEMBER CHAMPIONS

SUMMARY

A proposal has been received from the Reform UK Havering Group for the creation of four additional categories of Member Champion as detailed below. Under Article 2.3 of the Constitution, the creation of and subsequent appointment of Members to these positions is a matter for full Council to decide.
