Annex 2 - Conditions Consistent with the Operating Schedule

The prevention of crime and disorder

The CCTV system shall be in operation at the premises at all times when the premises are used for licensable activities. Recorded tapes shall be kept for 28 days and be available for inspection by police and Council officers at all reasonable times.

Staff shall undertake regular patrols during the day and night to check the security of the internal and external of the premises.

Members shall only be allowed admittance by scanning their membership cards and guests shall only be permitted entrance by being signed in and paid for by a staff member at reception.

Members shall carry their key cards with them at all times whilst on the premises.

Public safety

Health and Safety and Fire Safety Risk Assessments shall be undertaken on a regular basis.

Staff shall be trained in Health and Safety and Fire Risk issues on a regular basis. Notices shall be placed within the premises showing Fire Precaution and Fire Evacuation procedures.

Fire Evacuation Signage and fire fighting equipment shall be provided throughout the premises and shall be regularly checked.

The prevention of public nuisance

Music shall not be audible outside the premises after 22.00 hrs each evening.

The protection of children from harm

Children shall only be present at the Club up to 21.00 hrs where a table meal is consumed in the licensed area(s). If a table meal is ordered before 21.00 hrs, but the meal has not been consumed or is still awaited the child may remain in the licensed area(s) up to 21.30 hrs.

Children may go into the licensed area(s) when passing those areas to get to another unlicensed area, or when meals and non-alcoholic beverages are available for consumption in the licensed area(s)

After 21.00 hrs or 21.30 hrs, children on the premises shall be supervised in a crèche or child friendly play area that is not within or is separate from the licensed area(s).



Annex 3 - Conditions Attached after a Hearing by the Licensing Authority

Conditions

In addition to the use of Temporary Event Notices allowed under the Licensing Act 2003, the premises may open on 12 non-standard occasions, in line with the Association of Chief Police Officers guidelines; subject to a minimum of 10 working days' notice being given to the licensing authority and the Police for each occasion. The prior written consent of the Police shall be obtained and the police shall have absolute right to refuse any occasion.


A register shall be kept at the premises in the manner required by the Police and the Licensing Authority and available for inspection by the police or an Authorised Officer of the Licensing Authority and details of each occasion shall be recorded in it including the written consent of the police.

In addition:

- 1. No supply of alcohol to take place until the Licensing Service and police have seen evidence of the personal licence details of the DPS.
- Concerning the protection of children from harm: That where a cinema film or other programme includes a film recommended by the Licensing Authority as falling into the 12A, 15 or 18 category, no person appearing to be under the age of 12 or unaccompanied, or under 15 or 18 as appropriate, shall be admitted to any part of the programme; and the Licence Holder shall display in a conspicuous position, a notice confirming the age requirement.

The Metropolitan Police would like to make representation against the application to vary the Premises Licence at David Lloyd Leisure, Gidea Park RM2.

After a recent visit to the premises to inspect the CCTV system, I feel that the system is adequate to the requirements of the premises. This was initially high lighted in an incident report submitted to Havering police. The report states that the CCTV was of a poor quality and unusable for the investigation.

The function area of the bar is not covered by CCTV. The camera in this area covers the serving section at the bar. The intention in this application is to be open later; this in turn with the licence allows the club to provide occasional entertainment. I understand this includes private parties, for both members and non members. This produces some risk to allowing licensable activity till mid night at the weekends.

The licence includes many aspects of entertainment and inline with this application the applicant intends to extend all of these hours.

There is no mention of proving SIA security at the premises during these events.

I am not able to support this application, based on the applicant not meeting the requirements under the Crime Prevention and Disorder objective to a satisfactory level.

I am in support of the proposed amendments to the protection of children from harm. I would also like to see a challenge 21 policy in the bar area introduced, given that both member and non members are able to use the facilities during these events held at the club.

I would ask the applicant to read the Havering licensing policy and the pool of conditions relating to CCTV. In particular conditions; CD17, CD18, CD19, and CD21. This is available online from the London borough of Havering website.

I would seek to impose some of these conditions on to the licence if the licensing committee were to agree to the variation of the licence against this representation.
