Also issues with street lighting and parking on both sides of the street blocking views.	One-way would need to include Mill Park Avenue. One-way working likely to lead to an increase in traffic speeds (as there would be no oncoming traffic) and require deliveries to commercial areas to loop around residential streets. Point no-entry might reduce through traffic. Street lighting and parking issues referred to appropriate teams.
