We, the parents/carers of the children currently studying at Parsonage Farm Primary School, respectfully appeal against the expansion of Parsonage Farm Primary School. This appeal, in the form of a petition, is in accordance with the Statutory Notice issued upon the gates of the school, dated 28th March 2014.

The health and safety of our children is at the forefront of our campaign. The school is situated in a residential area, an area where during term times becomes excessively congested making parking virtually impossible. Children continue to suffer from the terrible parking and inconsideration of drivers. Although the school is not responsible for these drivers, we strongly feel that the increase in admission to the school will certainly create more congestion along these already overly tired roads, leading to further accidents. Many parents refuse to allow their children to walk to school unsupervised as they are deeply concerned about the safety of their child.

In September 2013, Parsonage Farm Primary School increased their intake from 60 to 90 pupils, the impact of which has led to overcrowding in the playground- another health and safety concern. General arguments in the playground amongst the children have become common, many of which stem from 'bumping' into one another or issues regarding personal space. Many children are reluctant to inform adults of such incidents as children often complain that they "couldn't see an adult". Surely the intake of yet another thirty children will make play and lunch times even more miserable for those who are already suffering.

The increase since September 2013, has also put further strain of the existing facilities at the school; the lower school children are squeezed into a small hall for their lunch and many children have complained about feeling rushed at lunch times as the hall is not big enough to accommodate all the children at one time. Some children return home with half eaten lunches which is not acceptable as all parents/carers pack an adequate amount of food for their child to maintain their strength and energy throughout the school day, but the fact that lunches aren't even being eaten properly suggests that many children may not be performing as well as they could.

In addition to the hall, the library tends to be in and out of use on a regular basis resulting in inconsistent group teaching, again another factor which hinders the child's learning. During ICT lessons two children are sharing one computer and the current procedure for dropping children off in the mornings is horrendous as the entrance gate is clearly overcrowded. Surely the school would benefit immensely from resolving such problems before inviting more children and parents to attend the school.

Furthermore, children's learning is also disrupted by the current building work; adults who come to collect the children after school can't even hear each other over the noise of the building work, just imagine how the children are coping under those conditions on a daily basis. This certainly isn't a

welcoming experience for the reception classes who can feel the floor shake beneath them as they try to concentrate. The distractions of the lorries entering and existing the site deters many from their tasks, these poor children are having to gain the 'best'(?) education on a building site! The most recent Ofsted report had highlighted that the school needed to improve provisions in the Early Years Foundation Stage, how can these provisions possibly be in place in such difficult circumstances?

As stated previously, Parsonage Farm Primary School had already increased their intake, wouldn't it be fair to give the other Rainham primary schools a chance for expansion? There are three other primary schools within 1.5miles of Parsonage Farm Primary School (Rainham Village Primary School, Brady and La Salette), one of which has completed an Outstanding Ofsted report, surely parents/carers would rather admit their children into an Outstanding school rather than a Good school like Parsonage Farm?

This leads me to ask the question, should Parsonage Farm not be more concerned about improving the standard of their school? Ofsted, in their 2011 report, had stressed the importance of raising the progress of the more-able children; with an increase in admissions into the school, will these more-able children be overlooked? Will the increase in pupils lead to a drop in the quality of 'Good' teaching? It is obvious that the teachers already rely heavily on the HLTAs and TAs, but with an increase in pupils the school must invest more into staffing, training for new staff as well as training for the existing teachers to ensure that all statutory requirements are met-more money which is depriving our children of new resources, an accessible library or even an improved ICT suite which could accommodate one computer per child.

Finally, the manner in which this proposal was presented to the parents was highly unprofessional. The initial consultation, dated March 2013, states that 75% of the participating people disapproved of the expansion of Parsonage. Despite this huge percentage, the council continued with their proposal and then asked the Governing Body of the school to vote upon the proposal, to which the council were delighted as the majority were in favour. Parsonage Farm Primary School, then sent questionnaires out to parents rather than inviting parents into the school to discuss this matter in a civilised manner. The structure of questionnaires limits one from expressing all of their concerns as questions tend to be closed or limited room is available to express oneself fully. We parents/carers feel that our opinions and feelings have been ignored and it was only since the initiation of this petition that the school invited parents to a 'drop in session' (rather than a formal meeting) where they could express their concerns. Ironically, the date of this drop in session is only twenty-four hours before the deadline for appealing against the proposal. Do the school and the council honestly believe that this can all be resolved in just twenty-four hours?

Parsonage Farm Primary School claims to be a 'community' school, yet it appears to be driving the community away from the school.

We wish to work with the school and the council to ensure that our children gain the best possible education, therefore we strongly urge the council to rethink its decision and save Parsonage Farm Primary School from turning into an overcrowded super school which lacks the facilities to help our children achieve their full potential.

The pupil numbers in the area started to increase in September 2012 and the school started taking 90 pupils since. The cohort size will increase on a yearly basis and the school is
		having permanent classrooms being built to replace the mobile class. If the expansion to 4 FE is agreed then the school will take 120 in Reception in Sept 2015 and again the cohort size will increase on a yearly basis rather than becoming a 840 place school on the 1 Sept 2015. Parsonage Farm is a good school and has the capacity to manage an increase in pupil numbers.
