Attention will be drawn to the clutter line which will be of high quality material and accommodate street furniture.

Proposed 450x600x63 concrete flag paving

Proposed 120x160x60 Marshalls tegular blocks in pennant grey or similar

Proposed 300x150x100 Tobermore city pave interlocking blocks on raised tables.  
Mixture of silver, mid grey and graphite

Carriageway to be resurfaced

Silver/ grey conservation kerbs to be installed on any new works

Raised table proposed at car park entrance and exit to assist pedestrian mobility

Proposed widening of existing island to reduce vehicles speeds on entry to Western Road

Proposed zebra crossing with central island to reduce pedestrian crossing distance

Proposed traffic island

Footway widened to anticipate an increase in pedestrians and to facilitate improvements to the public realm

Central reservation to be removed

Proposed clutter line for benches, bins and planters/ trees.

Proposed raised table to reduce vehicle speeds and to provide a level crossing facility for pedestrians

Proposed realignment to the entrance of Grimshaw Way

Existing traffic island to be reshaped

Liberty Shopping Centre  
Pedestrian Entrance

Potential areas of new adopted highway subject to agreement from Sovereign House. If agreed area will be converted to footway
