This Executive Decision approves the implementation of a short footway link and pair of dropped kerbs to serve the southbound bus stop opposite Braemar Gardens, following the completion of public consultation and at the recommendation of the Highways Advisory Committee as set out on the following drawing;

STATEMENT OF THE REASONS FOR THE DECISION

At its meeting of 8th December 2015, the Highways Advisory Committee considered a report on the proposals (copy attached) and the following recommendations;

- 1. That the Committee having considered the report and the representations made recommends to the Cabinet Member for Environment that one new, fully accessible, northbound bus stop be provided on Wingletye Lane from the choice of two locations, as set out in this report and shown on the following drawings (contained within Appendix I) be implemented;
 - (a) Option 1 Outside 215 to 221, Drawing QF001-OF-A257.1
 - (b) Option 2 Outside 203 to 207, Drawing QF001-OF-A257.2
- 2. That it be noted that the estimated cost of £6,000 for implementation of one option will be met by Transport for London through the 2015/16 Local Implementation Plan allocation for Bus Stop Accessibility.

The HAC, having considered the report, made the following Recommendations;

1. That none of the new stop options be implemented, but the proposed footway link and pair of dropped kerbs to serve the southbound bus stop opposite Braemar Gardens is implemented as shown on Drawing AN008-OF-A257.1 A.
