This application for a Review of the Premises Licence is made by PC Oisin Daly on behalf of the Metropolitan Police under section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003. The application was received by Havering's Licensing Authority on 21st October 2016.

Geographical description of the area and description of the building

New Tasty Chicken is a take away fast food premises, it is located on the north side of Victoria Road about 25 metres from the junction with South Street Romford and 100 metres walking distance from Romford Rail Station

The premises are within the Romford ring road. This area is therefore subject to a special policy further to cumulative impact.

The immediate vicinity in which the premises reside contains commercial and residential properties.

A map of the area is attached to my report to assist the Sub-Committee..

The Act requires the Licensing Authority to advertise the review, inviting representations to be made by responsible authorities or interested parties. An appropriately worded public notice advertising this application was placed at the premises, at Havering Town Hall and on Havering's website. on 21st and 24th October 2016. (Friday and Monday)

The venue has a Premises Licence number 2244 which permits Late Night Refreshment Sunday to Thursday 23:00 to 03:00, Friday & Saturday 23:00 to 04:00 the licence was transferred to the current holder Mr Amer Khan on 7th December 2015. A copy of the premises licence is attached to my report.

The police provided additional information to support their application on 3rd November 2016 this was e-mailed to the Licensing Authority, the licence holder Mr Khan and Mr Hopkins the licence holder's agent. This additional information is attached to the review application.
