This application for four Temporary Event Notices made by Aydemir Yatmaz under section 100 of the Licensing Act 2003. The application was received by Havering's Licensing Authority on 13<sup>th</sup> January 2012.

## Geographical description of the area and description of the building

The first two Temporary Event Notices (TENs) are for the 29<sup>th</sup> January 2012 and the second two are for the 5<sup>th</sup> February 2012 on both the first and second dates the TENs all relate to the same building but the Licensing Act 2003 allows the applicant to specify the area that the TEN will cover. On both of these dates one TEN refers to Bar 64 which is the front bar of the premises adjacent to South Street Romford and the second relates to the Club Ciroc which is the rest of the premises. All of the TENs apply to the sale of alcohol by retail, the provision of regulated entertainment and late night refreshment. All of the TENs apply for extended hours to follow on from the existing licence of the premises from 03.00 to 04.00.

The application forms were delivered to the licensing office by hand on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> January 2012 but because of irregularities on the form it could not be accepted until after a telephone call from the applicant and alterations made on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> January 2012 and a copy of the amended application was passed to the police licensing officer PC Fern.

I followed the procedure relating to TENs entered them onto our data base and returned a signed copy to the applicant acknowledging the TEN by post.

PC Dave Fern the Havering Police Licensing Officer made a representation against both Temporary Event Notices on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> January 2012.

Under the Licensing Act 2003 the police have two working days to lodge an objection to a TEN on the grounds of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder.

## Licensing Sub-Committee, 26th January 2012

A TEN allows the sale of alcohol, regulated entertainment and late night refreshment (hot food and drink 23.00hrs to 05.00hrs) for a limited period to take place without there being a licence but limits the number of people present to 499 (including staff) if both TENs were to be permitted this would cover 998 people on each date.

The premises are in the centre of Romford and very close to public transport.

## Re Temporary Event OBJECTION Notice(s) at: CLUB CIRCO and BAR 64

On 29/01/2012 and 05/02/2012

The Metropolitan Police will be objecting to your recent Temporary Event Notice(s) four (4) in total received at 1350 hours on Friday 13th January 2012 by the local authority.

Police have concerns that allowing the premises to be used in accordance with the notice would undermine the Crime Prevention Objective.

Police believe that the cumulative impact of these hours even on a temporary basis would have a negative impact on crime and disorder.

The premises holds one licence under the name Club Ciroc there is no mention of Bar 64. If the applicant intends to only use part of the premises for an event they must state this. I want to see how this will be controlled what measures will be in place and what capacity limit this is for. This must be within the London fire Brigades figures on occupancy. A plan of the premises can be submitted for clarification.

Holding two event notices must also be supported with a description of activity see section 2 of the application.

Part 5 of the licensing Act 2003 states under section 100 subsection 1-9 states what is required to be completed within the notice.

The crime pattern associated with the premises over the last four months raises my concern at how the operator is promoting the licensing objectives.

There has been a rise in crime at the location this related in assaults, GBH, ABH common assault along with reported incident of disputes and subjects being found drunk when exiting the premises. There was also a large disturbance at the premises resulting in a serious head injury, (GBH)

The management of the premises has changed. I am also aware of an incident on 27/12/2011 which involved the entire door staff team walking out. This creates further issues relating to crime and disorder and the safety of the club.

I was not served a copy of the notices by the applicant either, the administration of the applications are incorrect.

The police will continue to work with the applicant and any representative in an effort to resolve the matter.
