Tender Report

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1) Executive Summary

General Comments

Our detailed review of all the tenders received has revealed that one of the two tenders received was within Jacobs Pre Tender Estimate and appeared to be very competitive. However, both tenders received required further clarification to enable the tenders to be compared on a like for like basis. These clarifications are detailed in Section 7 of this report. Also, the responses to tender queries from both tenderers are detailed in Appendices A and B of this Report.

The tender received from T&B Contractors Limited was very competitive and was below Jacobs Pre Tender Estimate and did not include any tender clarifications.

Budget

Following the adjustment of the tenders referred to above the lowest tender of T&B Contractors Limited which totalled **£1,672,967.00** was below Jacobs Pre Tender Estimate of **£1,905,850.00** (excluding Risk, Jacobs Design Fees, VAT and Client's Contingency).

The tender received from T&B Contractors Limited was very competitive and was at a level lower than we would expect bearing in mind the complexity of this project and would therefore advise our Client to allow a contingency of **£150,000** to cover potential additional costs/claims that may arise.

Recommendation

After the pricing adjustments and the quality scoring T&B Contractors Limited are the preferred contractor to carry out the works, although as mentioned above there is concern that for this contractor the general level of pricing included in their tender is low which may give rise to claims for additional costs post contract.



2) Introduction

The aim of this tender report is to provide a detailed financial review of all the tenders received so that all the tenders can be compared on an equal cost basis in order to determine the true value of each tender submitted, which will form part of the overall assessment process.

This tender report provides a detailed analysis of both the commercial and technical aspects of the tenders received for the proposed extension and refurbishment of the existing Nursery, New ARP Modular Classroom Block, Condition Works to existing Infants Block and associated external works and drainage at Mead Primary School in order to make a recommendation for the selection of a contractor for the project. This project was procured on a JCT Standard Building Contract Without Quantities 2016 Edition and on a Single Stage Competitive tender basis with a contract period of 16 weeks.

The scoring and selection criteria used in this Report are as set out in London Borough of Havering's Instructions to Tenderers. In summary, the tender assessment and selection was to be based on both 'quality' and 'price' with the 'price' submission accounting for 70% of the marks and the 'quality' submission for 30% of the marks.

Contractors were invited to submit tenders under the East London Solutions Framework from a Value Band of £500,000 to £3,500,000 and those who expressed an interest to submit a bone fide tender were as follows;

Borras Construction Limited T&B (Contractors) Limited Rooff Limited Barnes Construction Limited

Of the four Contractors invited to submit tenders only two Contractors submitted a tender to London Borough of Havering on 18th April 2018.

It is a Public Sector requirement for the selection process to evaluate the tenders on a like for like basis so that the score given to each tender was the true score for their tender.

The tender received from Borras Construction was qualified and these were resolved through the tender clarification process as detailed in Appendix B of this Report.

Both tenders excluded/included certain items that were/were not required and these were resolved through the tender clarification process as detailed in Appendices A & B of this Report.

Hence it was necessary to adjust the tenders for the excluded/included items before applying a financial score to them.



3) Budget

Jacobs Pre Tender Estimate for the construction works contained in the tender documentation totalled **£1,905,850.00** excluding Risk, Jacob's Design Fees, VAT and Client's Contingency. There were three addendums issued on the portal during the tender period, addendum one was the revised preliminaries, addendum two was Sustainability Report and addendum three was the revised Planning Permission. None of the addendums affected the Pre Tender Estimate.



4) Tenders Received

The tenderers were requested to submit offers based upon a Contract period of 16 weeks.

The tenders that were returned were requested to provide a Priced Contract Sum Analysis Programme, Method Statement and responses to the Quality Questions as part of their tender offer.

Both tenderers provided reasonably detailed tenders.

The tender evaluation process requires the examination of all the tenders received to allow the tenders to be compared on an equal basis.

The findings from our financial examination of the tenders received are detailed in the following sections of this report.



5) Comparison of Tenders (Tenders Unadjusted)

'Table 1' below provides a summary of the costs for each of the key work package elements submitted within the tenders received for the project.

9) Recommendation

<u>General</u>

Four Contractors were invited to submit tenders and two offers were received.

Of the two tenders received both were generally well prepared and provided, in the main, the information that was requested. The tender provided by T&B Contractors Limited was not qualified, however, the tender received from Borras Construction Limited included a list of tender qualifications and clarifications.

Our detailed review of all the tenders received has revealed that both tenders required further clarification and, in order to compare the tenders on a like for like basis, both tenderers were subsequently asked to clarify some of the costs. This resulted in the need to adjust the tender figures that were received on the 18th April 2018 in line with the details scheduled in Section 7 and Appendices A and B of this Report.

The tenders received appeared competitive and the lowest tenders received from T&B Contractors Limited was very competitive which was surprising considering the market conditions that currently exist in the Construction Industry at the moment. T&B Contractors Limited were asked to confirm the level of overheads of profit they required for variations during the post tender period. Whilst the allowance included in the tender by T&B Contractors for overheads and profit at 2.5% was quite low, the allowance required for post contract variations for overheads and profit of 15% is high, which would make any variations quite expensive.

<u>Budget</u>

Only the tender received from T&B Contractors Limited was below Jacobs Pre Tender Estimate of £1,905,850 after the adjustments outlined in Section 7 above.

The tenderers received excluded the risks associated with unforeseen ground conditions which include the removal of contaminated material, breaking out obstructions and the removal/diversion of existing services. Whilst the current surveys and reports indicate the risk of finding contamination is small both tenderers did not include these risks in their tender price. Jacobs have therefore included Provisional Sums in the tender comparison to allow for the potential discovery of the risks identified above. There is also a risk that the existing mechanical and electrical service installations may need modification to accommodate the new works and a Provisional Sum has been included in the tender summary to cover this requirement. Both tenderers were notified of the additional Provisional Sums required and have confirmed the adjustments made to their tenders to include these Provisional Sums as detailed in Appendices A & B via the Capital E Sourcing Portal.

The tender received from T&B Contractors Limited was very competitive and was at a level lower than we would expect bearing in mind the current market conditions and would therefore recommend a contingency allowance be made for potential additional costs/claims that may arise.

Recommendation

T&B Contractors Limited was the lowest tender after the commercial adjustments outlined above (excluding the quality assessment) and included a tender programme of 16 weeks, albeit they wish to commence two weeks earlier than planned and this revised programme would need to be agreed with the School as they wish to



commence two weeks prior to the end of the summer term. T&B Contractors provided a very competitive but fairly well considered tender and was submitted without any technical qualifications or clarifications.

Borras Contractors Limited was the highest tender after the commercial adjustments outlined above (excluding the quality assessment) based on a tender programme of 16 weeks and provided a competitive but fairly well considered tender from a commercial aspect. It must be noted that Borras Contractors Limited's tender included a list of qualifications and clarifications which have subsequently been closed out.

However, after the pricing adjustments and the quality scoring T&B Contractors Limited are the preferred contractor to carry out the works, although as mentioned above there is concern that for this contractor the general level of pricing included in their tender is low which may give rise to claims for additional costs post contract and we would therefore recommend that Havering allocate a contingency for this risk.

Outstanding Issues

There are a number of issues that would need to be resolved prior to the appointment of the Contractor and these are as follows:

- Agreement to the Main Contractors Programme and Method Statements.
- Agreement of the Contractors Proposals for the ARP
- Agreement of appointed contractors Health and Safety Information.
- Provision of Cash Flow based on the Contract Programme.
- Provision and agreement of an Information Release Schedule.
- Production of Site Waste Management Plan

It is unlikely that all these issues will be resolved prior to appointment of the Contractor and therefore these items will remain a risk to London Borough of Havering and will rely on a proactive approach of the Contractor to resolve the issues amicably.
