LAUNDERS LANE SITE, RAINHAM

Motion on behalf of the Conservative Group

In light of the deteriorating situation at site in Launderers Lane, Rainham, which is placing significant pressure on the local Fire Service, this Council calls for a public meeting to be held for local residents, councillors, and other stakeholders; and for the establishment of a steering committee to receive quarterly updates on the site.

Amendment on behalf of the Havering Residents Association Group

Council is aware of the situation in Launderers Lane, Rainham and notes the ability of local ward councillors address concerns by means of meetings with residents, Councillors or such other stakeholders and to use the Council's Scrutiny function as a mechanism for reviewing health and safety concerns of residents.

ULTRA LOW EMISSION ZONE (ULEZ) EXPANSION

Motion on behalf of the Conservative Group

That Havering Council oppose the introduction of the ULEZ expansion, by all means within its power, and that the administration make representation to TfL and the Mayor of London opposing the ULEZ expansion to the Borough.

Amendment on behalf of the Labour Group

While Havering Council opposes the introduction of the ULEZ expansion, it recognises the impact of poor air quality on the lives of Havering residents. This Council moves that the administration make representation to TfL and the Mayor of London regarding measures that can be taken to offset the impact of vehicular pollution and reduce the number of unnecessary journeys made, without a regressive flat-rate tax which will impact our less well-off residents disproportionately.
