THERE is excepted and reserved unto the Commission in fee simple:-

(a) the right at any time to erect or suffer to be erected any buildings or other erections and to alter any building or other erections now standing or hereafter to be erected on any part of their adjoining or neighbouring land in such a manner as to obstruct or interfere with the passage of light or air to any building which is or may be erected upon the property and any access of light and air over the adjoining land of the Commission shall be deemed to be enjoyed by the licence or consent of the Commission and not as of right

(b) the right of support from the property for the adjoining property of the Commission

(c) the free right of passage and running of water and soil from any part of the adjoining land of the Commission through any sewers drains and watercourses which may hereafter be constructed under the property with full right and liberty in perpetuity but in common with the Corporation and their successors in title (and all other persons having a like right) to make connection with and drain into such sewers drains or watercourses in connection with and for the purposes of the drainage of the railway and works of the Commission

(d) full right and liberty for the Commission and their successors in title with or without workmen at all reasonable times to enter upon the property for the purpose of exercising all or any of the rights reserved by paragraph (c) of this clause and for the purpose of repairing and cleaning any sewers drains or watercourses and for the purpose of maintaining repairing renewing reinstating altering or removing any fences walls railway banks abutment or retaining walls bridges and other works of the Commission on their adjoining or neighbouring land.
