I am emailing in respect of the attached TEN application.

As part of my statutory duty to assess and prevent potential nuisance, I have reviewed this application and must raise a formal objection in its current form.

The proposed hours for the provision of amplified music, in the absence of a Noise Management Plan (NMP), present a high likelihood of causing a statutory nuisance. Additionally, there are no clear measures in place to mitigate noise impacts associated with patrons leaving the premises during the early morning hours.

It is important to note that there are residential properties in the immediate vicinity, which further heightens the potential for noise disturbance.

Given these concerns, I am unable to support the application as submitted.
