This application for a premises licence is made by Tharsan Sivasaravanamuthu under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003. The application was properly received by Havering's Licensing Authority on the 06<sup>th</sup> November 2025.

The premises are situated within Hornchurch Town Centre.

#### **Details of the application**

The application is to authorise off-sales of alcohol from Monday to Sunday with hours of 08:00-23:00.

The description provided in the application is "The business is located in a midterrace ground floor retail unit situated in a busy main road in Hornchurch Town Centre with residential accommodation above. The business will operate as a convenience store and off licence".

Prior to the application being submitted the agent engaged with the authorities seeking advice given the location being in a CIZ. They were advised of conditions that would be desirable around limited hours, ABV% and multi pack sales – these and additional conditions were included in the application.

#### Comments and observations on the application

The applicant acted in accordance with regulations 25 and 26 of *The Licensing Act 2003 (Premises licences and club premises certificates) Regulations 2005* relating to the advertising of the application. The required public notice was installed in the 14<sup>th</sup> November 2025 edition of the Romford Recorder.
